“Feuersee Zero Hour” – Theatre Production

We have secured a limited number of tickets for what promises to be a unique and entertaining production at the Theatrehaus Stuttgart.

This is a joint program with the MetClub Stuttgart.

The Anglophone Collaborative Theatre of Stuttgart (ACTS) presents the newly discovered memoirs of Hildegard Freud in the form of a 90 minute play entitled “Feuersee Zero Hour”, offering audiences a unique perspective of life in war-torn Stuttgart between 1942 and 1945.

As a prisoner of war, Freud was ordered to take the position of interpreter and hotel worker at the once prestigious Hotel Marquardt in Stuttgart, where she found herself at odds with the oppressive Ultra-Nazi hotel management. As the demand for forced labour increased, so did the threat of being transferred to hard labour camps. Freud survived however, despite her protests against the unjust treatment of the hotel work force and her refusal to use the Hitler salute.

Paradoxically she discovered the power of passionate love, falling for the charms of Andre Freud, a French prisoner assigned to the Klett Works in Stuttgart as a printing engineer. Through a haze of emotional liberation, she endured the twin horrors of Nazi terror and the allied bombing. Tickets are Euro 15.00 per person.
