The Weissenhofsiedlung comprises 21 houses constructed within 21 weeks by well-known architects for an exhibition in 1927. Some years ago the Metclub visited the Weissenhofsiedlung and had an opportunity to see the interior of a house designed by Le Corbusier. Shortly after our visit this house was renovated for three years. The building has now reopened as a museum featuring its original interior of 1927. There will be a guided tour for us in English taking about 45 minutes. After the tour we will have a look at some houses of the Weissenhofsiedlung and will go then to the nearby 'Naturfreundehaus Steinbergle' where we can enjoy the summer evening with some grilled food, a vegetarian meal or just a drink.


